Costume Week- April 25-28th

The last week of April, we will pass out costumes to parents at dance classes. We encourage parents to come to the last 20 minutes of your dancer's class. They will be trying on costumes, performing a sneak preview of the routine for you. This is the perfect opportunity to take a video for your dancer to practice with. YOU MUST HAVE PAID ALL TUITION, LATE FEES, RECITAL FEE, AND COSTUME BALANCES TO RECEIVE YOUR COSTUMES. NO EXCEPTIONS!

• FAQ #1: Where can I find specific information for my dancer's costume?

 During costume week, you will receive a printout of all your tights and accessories if applicable.

FAQ #2: Will I receive tights?

- You will receive tights with your costume IF your child's class is wearing them. The cost was already included in your costume balance if needed.
- o If you would like to exchange your tights for another size, please do NOT open them.

FAQ #3: Will I receive a hair accessory or additional costume pieces/props?

 You may receive additional accessories IF your child's class has any. Some we also provide the day of the recital backstage.

FAQ #4: Will I receive shoes?

 No, these are your responsibility to provide. Please see the front desk to get them ordered ASAP if you do not have the proper style/color.

• FAQ #5: What other costume items does my dancer need?

Depending on their age you may need a dance bra / straps.

FAQ #6: How do I care for the costume?

- Take it out of the bag and let it hang in a safe place.
- Tutus can be hung upside down from the crotch to get "fluffier".
- o Those with satin like material may need to use a steamer on their costume.
- DO NOT WASH THEM IN THE WASHING MACHINE!
- o Do NOT let your child eat or drink anything except water in their costume.

FAQ #7: How should I transport my costumes?

• We recommend purchasing garment bags if your child is in multiple routines.

There are 3 ways to purchase tickets - Ticket sales begin Friday, April 29th @ 9 a.m.



- 3. At the show There will be LIMITED tickets available for sale the day of the show
 - Cash and debit/credit cards accepted

More seating/ticketing details

- FAQ #1: Is it assigned seating?
 - Yes! The sooner you purchase your ticket, the closer seats you will get.
- FAQ #2: How much are tickets?
 - \$15 each
- FAQ #3: Who needs a ticket?
 - You must buy tickets for EACH show you wish to attend.
 - o Dancers in the show do NOT need a ticket, they will be backstage.
 - Children 3 & under sitting on laps do NOT need a ticket.
- FAQ #4: Do I have to watch each show?
 - No this is not required. However, often at least 1 parent stays for each show their dancer is performing in.
- FAQ #5: Can I purchase tickets the day of the show?
 - Yes, at the venue with cash or card
- FAQ #6: Will programs be passed out when entering the recital?
 - No, 2 souvenir programs were included with your recital fee and will be given to you as you check in your dancer. Additional programs may be purchased for \$5 each.

Hair, Make-up, Jewelry, Tips & Tricks

- FAQ #1: How should my dancer wear their hair?
 - o All girls should wear their hair in a high sock bun.
 - We recommend using bun builders to help!
 - All boys should be clean cut and use hairspray to secure their hair.



- Yes, all girls should AT LEAST wear blush and red lipstick.
 - Older girls, or brave moms, may add mascara, eyeliner, foundation, eyeshadow, and fake eyelashes.
 - Please do not use crazy bright colored eye shadow.
 - Use browns, creams, tans, white, black to create a stage smokey eye as pictured.
- FAQ #3: Can my dancer wear jewelry?
 - Only dance earrings allowed. No bracelets, rings, or necklaces please.

We do sell dance earrings for \$15 and bun builders for \$7 in the lobby for if interested.

- Please be careful not to distract your dancer. Remain quiet in the audience. Each dancer should only have ONE parent present at dress rehearsal.

- FAQ #1: What time should my dancer arrive?
 - 30 minutes before show time 5:00 p.m.
- FAQ #2: Where should my dancer go?
 - There will be BACKSTAGE signs and staff at a check-in table at the door in the lower part of the lobby. This is also when you will receive your 2 souvenir programs.
- FAQ #3: Should my dancer be in their costume?
 - Yes, please have them completely ready to go when you drop them off.

- FAQ #4: How long will the show last?
 - Approximately 2.5 hours.
- FAQ #5: When can I go to my seat?
 - The seating will open 30 minutes prior to the start of the show.
- FAQ #6: Where will my child be during the show?
 - Dancers with multiple costume changes will be backstage assisted by staff and volunteers.
 - Dancers with few or no costume changes will be watching the show in the balcony supervised by staff and volunteers.
- FAQ #7: Can I go backstage with my dancer?
 - No, only dancers are allowed backstage.
- FAQ #8: Can I see my dancer during intermission?
 - o No
- FAQ #9: Can I leave after my dancer's number?
 - Please refrain from leaving in the middle of the show. It is polite to stay the entire performance to watch the dancers' hard work! They don't want to see empty seats You will miss awards bows.
- FAQ #10: Where & when do I pick up my dancer?
 - o Dancers 9+ will be instructed to meet their families in the lobby
 - Dancers under 9 may have **ONE same-sex** parent go backstage after the recital to help their dancer.

- FAQ #1: What time should my dancer arrive?
 - 20 minutes before show time 4:10 pm
- FAQ #2: Where should my dancer go?
 - There will be BACKSTAGE signs and staff at a check-in table at the door in the lower part of the lobby. This is also when you will receive your 2 souvenir programs.
- FAQ #3: Should my dancer be in their costume?
 - Yes, please have the completely ready to go when you drop them off.
- FAQ #4: How long will the show last?
 - Approximately 1 hour 15 minutes. There will not be an intermission.
- FAQ #5: When can I go to my seat?
 - The seating will open 30 minutes prior to the start of the show.
- FAQ #6: Where will my child be during the show?
 - Dancers will be backstage assisted by staff and volunteers.
- FAQ #7: Can I go backstage with my dancer?
 - No, only dancers are allowed backstage.
- FAQ #8: Can I leave after my dancer's number?
 - Please refrain from leaving in the middle of the show. It is polite to stay the entire performance to watch the dancers' hard work! They don't want to see empty seats You will miss awards & bows.
- FAQ #9: Where & when do I pick up my dancer?

 Dancers must have one parent pick them up the check-in table after the show.
